Cookie policy

Legal context

In accordance with the requirements of Directive (EU) 2002/58/EC ("E-Privacy Directive") and Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (the "GDPR Regulation") applicable from 25 May 2018, we are required to securely manage the personal data you provide to us through the use of our website in accordance with the provisions of the GDPR Regulation and the E-Privacy Directive and only for the specified purposes.

In particular, the GDPR Regulation requires us, first, to provide the user with the possibility to express or, where applicable, withdraw their consent to the processing of their personal data at any time, to rectify the content of personal data, and, secondly, to inform users about the content of the cookies used by our website, what categories of users' personal data are processed by our cookies, what we do with the information obtained by cookies and where we store that information, providing a high level of security for the information collected by cookies, the possibility for the user to block at any time the

running of any or all cookies from our website, as well as the deletion of information collected by cookies.

What is a "cookie"?

An "Internet Cookie" (also known as a "*browser* cookie" or "*HTTP* cookie" or simply a "cookie") is a small file consisting of letters and numbers that will be stored on a user's computer, mobile device or other equipment from which the Internet is accessed.

There are two main categories of cookies:

1. *Session cookies* – these are temporarily stored in the cookie folder of the web browser so that it can remember them until the user leaves the website or closes the browser window.
2. *Persistent cookies* – these are stored on the hard drive of a computer or device (and generally depend on the pre-set lifetime of the cookie).

Persistent cookies also include those placed by a website other than the one the user is visiting at the time – known as '*third-party* cookies'.

Your consent to the use of cookies

Once you access our website, you will be greeted by a message asking for your consent to accept or decline cookies during your visit to our website, including the secure storage of the information collected by them.

Until the accept/decline process for the use of cookies is completed, no cookies will be placed on your device, except for functional cookies.

This website uses its own and third-party cookies to provide visitors with a better browsing experience and services tailored to their needs and interests.

Withdrawing consent for the use of cookies?

Users can change or withdraw their consent to the use of cookies at any time by using the "Cookie settings" option available on the website or by deleting cookies from their browser settings.

What are third-party cookies?

Certain sections of content on some websites may be provided by third parties/suppliers (e.g. *news box, video or advertisement*). These third parties may also place cookies through the website, and these are called "*third-party cookies*" because they are not placed by the owner of the website. Third-party providers must also comply with applicable law and the privacy policies of the website owner.

Security and privacy issues

Cookies are NOT viruses! They use plain text formats. They are not made up of pieces of code, so they cannot be executed or self-executing. Consequently, they cannot be duplicated or replicated on other networks to run or replicate again. Since they cannot perform these functions, they cannot be considered viruses. Cookies can, however, be used for negative purposes. Because they store information about users' preferences and browsing history, both on a particular site and on several other sites, cookies can be used as a form of spyware. Many anti-spyware products are aware of this and constantly mark cookies for deletion during anti-virus / anti-spyware scanning / deletion procedures.
