Privacy policy

1. Preamble

This document describes the policies and practices regarding the collection and use of your personal data and sets out your privacy rights.

Ensuring the confidentiality of information received from users is an ongoing responsibility and requires periodic updating of the provisions of this document, as we implement new measures imposed by specific legislation or adopt new privacy policies.

The need to use certain specialized services or technologies through which www.teachenglishinromania.com to be able to perform its duties may justify the empowerment of third parties (the data will not be transmitted simultaneously to all the empowered parties). We undertake with all responsibility to respect the confidentiality of your personal data and to treat all personal data provided by you as confidential, processing, when the situation requires it. The use of Google services (YouTube, Google Maps and Google Analytics) may involve the transfer of technical data to servers located outside the European Union, including in the United States of America. These transfers are carried out in accordance with applicable data

protection legislation and with protection mechanisms approved by the European Commission, such as the Standard Contractual Clauses (SCC).

2. Legislation

As of May 25, 2018, it became applicable Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter referred to as "GDPR regulation"). According to the provisions of this normative act, we are obliged to manage the personal data you provide to us by using the site safely and only for the specified purposes, namely information.

3. Data Protection Officer

According to the provisions GDPR Regulation, for questions, concerns or requests related to the exercise of legal rights regarding the processing of your personal data, we invite you to contact this person. 4. Collection and use of personal data

4.1 Personal information you provide to us:

To provide you with quality services, we may collect, store and use the following types of personal data:

- information about the device you use, your visits to and navigation within this website (including IP address, geographical location, browser type and version, operating system);
- information you provide to us if you create an individual access account (including your contact details), if applicable;
- information you provide to us for the purpose of subscribing to email notifications or communications (including name and email address), if applicable;
- information you provide to us when you use the services or information derived from the use of these services (including the frequency and typology of use of the services), if applicable;

- information contained in communications you send to us directly or via the form available on the site (including the content of the communication and the data associated with the communication);
- Through the Registration Form, you send personal data so that we can triage you for involvement in subsequent camp activities.

4.2 You have the option not to provide us with your personal data

4.3 Purposes of using personal data

(1) let. f) of the GDPR Regulation:** if you contact us, either through this site or otherwise, we may process your name, contact details, location and other information you provide to us in order to answer your questions, to arrange a meeting, telephone call or other type of communication, to triage you for further involvement in the camp activities;

4.3.2 Marketing and public relations, based on your consent, as appropriate **art. 6 para. (1) let. a) of the GDPR Regulation:** if you are a visitor to our website, we may process through cookies and web beacons your IP address, geographic location, browser type and version, operating system, interactions with our website where applicable.

4.3.3 Security, based on the legitimate interest of teachenglishinromania.com, according to **art. 6 para. (1) let. f) of the GDPR Regulation:** if you are a visitor to our website, we may process the personal data you have provided to us, data collected automatically about you or your device (e.g. cookies, web beacons, etc.), in accordance

with this privacy notice, to ensure the protection of this website against fraud, as well as intellectual property rights.

We note that this information may be disclosed to the authorities, under the law, for the purpose of investigation or criminal prosecution.

5. Disclosure and transfer of personal data

The information we collect from you will be processed in the European area and/or outside it, depending on the purpose of the processing. (YouTube, Google Maps and Google Analytics).

We assure you that we strive to apply appropriate measures to guarantee the protection of the confidentiality and security of your personal data during transfer and to use it only in accordance with the provisions set forth in this Privacy Policy.

To the extent permitted by applicable data protection law, we may use your personal data with clients (e.g. to demonstrate the quality of our services), auditors, agencies, supervisory authorities or other external service providers to full fill our contractual obligations. We will clearly indicate to you each data recipient, if it is well known at the time of processing.

We may also disclose your personal data:

- where the law requires us to do so, in connection with legal proceedings;
- to establish, exercise or defend legal rights (for the purpose of fraud prevention).

6. Your rights

Conformable GDPR Regulation, you have the following specific rights:

- to access and rectify (correct) the recording of your personal data, if it is inaccurate;
- to request the deletion of data or the cessation of its processing, subject to certain exceptions;
- to request that we stop using your data for direct marketing purposes (YouTube, Google Maps and Google Analytics);
- to file a complaint with the data protection authority if you have concerns about how we process your personal data;
- to request, where technically feasible, the transmission of your personal data directly or to another controller. If access cannot be provided within a reasonable time, we will provide you with a date on which the information will be transmitted;
- to request additional information about the purpose of the processing, the categories of personal data concerned, what was the source of the information and how long it will be stored.

7. Retention of personal data

We process personal data only after obtaining your consent and retain it for an unlimited period of time or until consent is revoked (unless legal requirements provide otherwise and this is necessary for the purpose of the processing).

If you do not provide us with or revoke your consent to data processing, we will only store the minimum data absolutely necessary (full name, contact details, references and notes), to the extent that our legitimate interest or other legal basis justifies this.

At the same time, we will retain information and documents containing personal data (including electronic documents):

- if the information and documents are relevant to any legal proceedings;
- to establish, exercise or protect our legal rights (including for the purpose of preventing fraud).

8. Security of personal data

To protect the confidentiality of the personal data and information you provide to us, we take technical and administrative measures that we constantly update and test.

Access to your personal data is restricted to employees who need the information to provide you with benefits or services. In this context,

our employees are trained on the importance of ensuring the confidentiality and security of the information you provide.

If a personal data breach occurs, we will do our utmost to eliminate it, while assessing the level of risk arising from it, in accordance with our personal data breach policy. If it is found that the data breach in question may cause you physical harm, material or non-material damage (for example, discrimination, identity theft, fraud or financial loss), we will contact you without undue delay, except where otherwise required by law. The actions we will take will be in full cooperation with the competent supervisory authority.

9. Changes to the privacy policy

Given that the legislation on personal data protection, interpretations and recommendations of state bodies and supervisory authorities will undergo changes, we reserve the right to modify this information document at any time, for any reason and without notice.
